Clothing Closet Guidelines

Hours of operation: 9:00 am – 10:30 am (when on Saturdays)

- + Re-sellers are **STRONGLY** discouraged from participating
- + “Bulk” grabbing is not allowed
- + Guests must provide their own transportation
- + Guests must be able to carry out the items that they receive from the Closet
- + **1 bag (supplied)** maximum between the hours of 9:00 am and 9:45 am: keep your bag with you at all times (after 9:45 am: unlimited bags allowed)
- + **2 pairs** of shoes maximum per bag between the hours of 9:00 am and 9:45am
- + Please speak to one of us if you feel that this limits your family or organization’s needs
