### Ten Reasons to Believe In a Pre-Tribulation Rapture

1. The Bible never says the Church will go through the Tribulation Period.
2. The Church had no part in the first sixty-nine weeks of Daniel and it will have no part in the seventieth week (Daniel 9:24).
3. The Church is mentioned more than twenty times in the first three chapters of Revelation, but there is no mention of the Church between Revelation 4:1 and Revelation 19:1.
4. Jesus comes to meet his Church in the Rapture (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17). He comes with his Church in the Second Coming (1 Thessalonians 3:13). The Church goes up from the earth in the Rapture and it comes down to the earth in the Second Coming.
5. The Antichrist cannot be revealed until after the Rapture (2 Thessalonians 2:6-8). But if the Church goes through the Tribulation Period, the Church will know who the Antichrist is because he will head up the one-world government (Revelation 13:10); put a statue of himself in the rebuilt Temple (Matthew 24:15); demand that people take his Mark, name, or number (Revelation 13:15-17); kill the Two Witnesses (Revelation 11:7), and more.
6. No one can know the day or hour of the Second Coming (Matthew 24:36). But if the Church goes through the Tribulation Period, some will know the day because it will be seven years from the signing of the seven-year covenant (Daniel 9:24-27) and 1,260 days from the day the Antichrist defiles the Temple (Revelation 12:6).
7. The Church must go to heaven for the marriage of the Lamb (Revelation 19:7) before the Second Coming at the end of the Tribulation Period (Revelation 19:11-14).
8. The Antichrist will prevail against the saints during the Tribulation Period (Revelation 13:7), but the gates of hell won't prevail against the Church (Matthew 16:18).
9. The twenty-four elders (representatives of the Church) will be in heaven before the seven-sealed scroll is broken.
10. The Pre-Tribulation Rapture is more consistent with God's grace, love, and mercy.
